



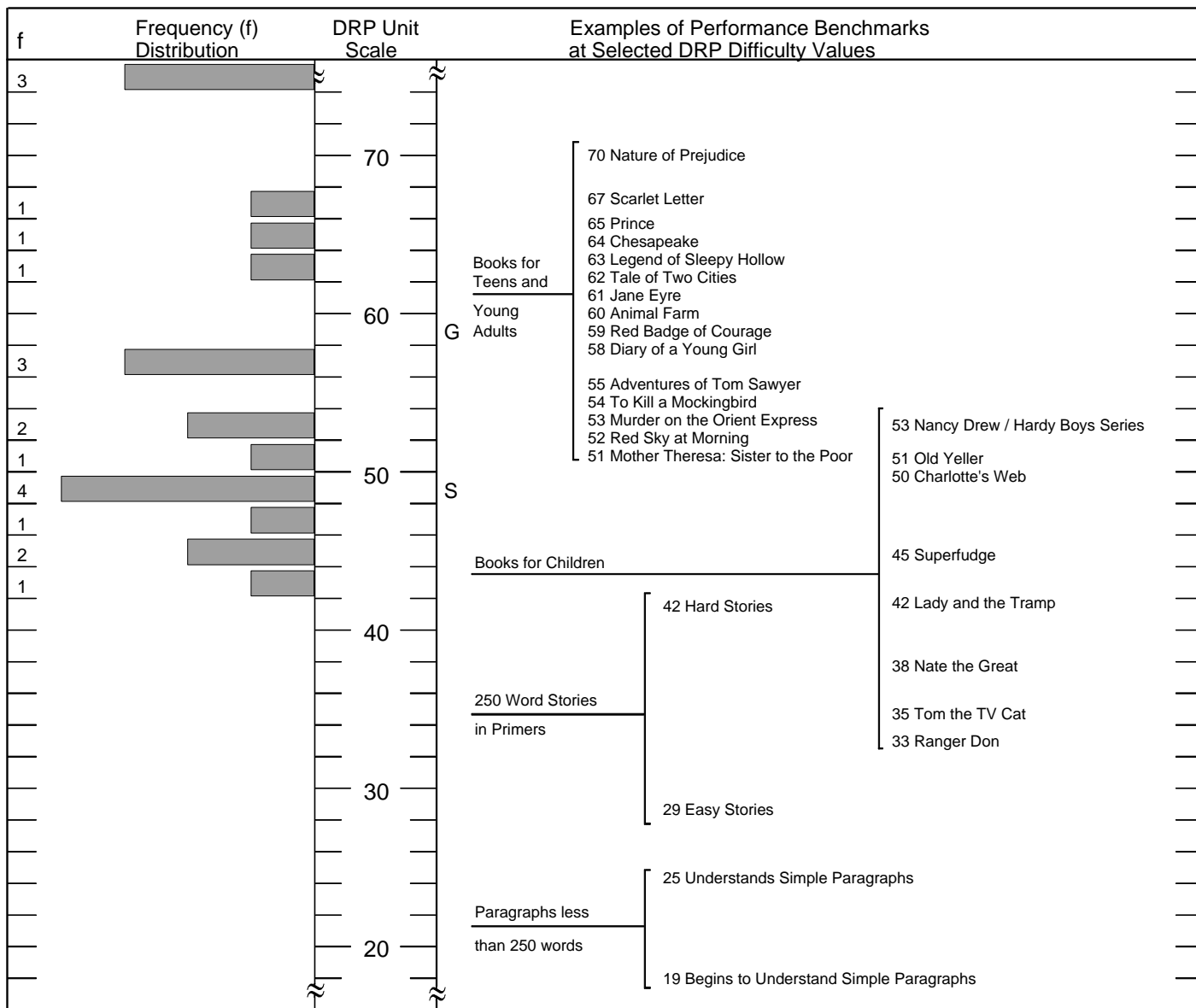

Standard DRP Test Scores

District: **Central Schools**

Primary and Standard DRP tests assess the ability to comprehend the surface meaning of text while it is being read. Surface understanding is a necessary prerequisite for being able to reason with, that is, analyze, evaluate, and extend the ideas that are presented in increasingly more difficult text. Because DRP Scores are on the same DRP unit scale as text difficulty, examples of materials which your students are able to comprehend can be obtained from the chart below.

Instructional DRP Scores (P=.75) indicate the most difficult text that students can comprehend with assistance from teachers or parents. Independent DRP Scores (P = .90) indicate the most difficult text that students can comprehend without any help. **Instructional DRP Scores** are plotted in the chart below.
